NOTICE OF MODIFICATION TO TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS AND CORRECTION TO THE NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING

AUTOMATED FIREARMS SYSTEM INFORMATION UPDATES

Updates to Proposed Text

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8 (c), and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the California Department of Justice (Department) is providing notice of modification to text of the proposed regulation sections 4350, 4351, 4352, and 4353, which were the subject of a public comment period which closed on November 7, 2018.

Correction to the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking

In the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, the “Disclosures Regarding the Proposed Action” section, the Department stated: “Cost or savings to any state agency: There will be a cost for the Department to hire additional personnel to verify each AFS record update and additional cost to maintain the AFS. The Department projects there will be approximately one million (1,000,000) AFS record updates completed in the first year that these regulations are in effect.”

This statement was incorrect. The Results of the Economic Impact Assessment/Analysis within the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, and the Standard 399 Economic and Fiscal Impact Statement are both correct in that there is no fiscal impact to the Department regarding this regulatory rulemaking.
