In this emergency readopt of OAL Matter No. 2019-0617-04E, the Department of Justice ("DOJ") is adopting additional documentation requirements for eligibility checks on any application or report for which an applicant is required to submit a driver license or identification card, or the number from a driver license or identification card, so that DOJ may determine the applicant's eligibility to possess a firearm or ammunition under state or federal law.

OAL approves this emergency regulatory action pursuant to sections 11346.1 and 11349.6 of the Government Code.

This emergency regulatory action is effective on 12/31/2019 and will expire on 3/31/2020. The Certificate of Compliance for this action is due no later than 3/30/2020.
